Manufactured home requirements:

- Florida septic permits are now a state DEP program, but this county's health department Environmental Health office still takes the applications and issues the permits locally

MANUFACTURED HOME NOTES

- Mobile home move-on permits require septic tank approval or existing-tank letter from Environmental Health, 301 South West Street, Green Cove Springs, 904-529-2840
- Green Cove Springs, Orange Park, Keystone Heights, and Penney Farms run their own building programs; confirm the site is in unincorporated Clay County first
- County code Chapter 13 covers mobile homes/vehicles/trailers; Appendix C has zoning regulations

Florida: installations follow FS 320 and Rule 15C-1/15C-2 (DHSMV) with licensed installers and installation decals; county building permits, tie-down and wind-zone compliance apply. Coastal counties may require Wind Zone II/III homes.
