Manufactured home requirements:

- Florida septic permits are now a state DEP program, but this county's health department Environmental Health office still takes the applications and issues the permits locally
- Separate mobile home parks program

MANUFACTURED HOME NOTES

- Publishes a dedicated Mobile Home Application checklist for new or used homes; permit fees roughly SW \$325, DW \$375, TW \$425 plus review and special assessment fees
- Land Development Regulations include mobile-home zoning districts (e.g., RSF/MH mixed single-family/mobile home and RMH-P mobile home park)
- Hours Monday-Friday 8:00 am to 4:30 pm; email bldginfo@columbiacountyfla.com

Florida: installations follow FS 320 and Rule 15C-1/15C-2 (DHSMV) with licensed installers and installation decals; county building permits, tie-down and wind-zone compliance apply. Coastal counties may require Wind Zone II/III homes.
