### Manufactured home requirements:

- Florida septic permits are now a state DEP program, but this county's health department Environmental Health office still takes the applications and issues the permits locally
- County posts its own new-OSTDS-permit requirements document

## MANUFACTURED HOME NOTES

- Mobile home permit package requires impact fee receipt or deferral letter, a driveway permit if on a county-maintained road, and septic permit/health department approval where applicable.
- Placement in a rental park requires written park permission before the permit is released.
- Owner must provide legal sewage, water, and electric service and meet the county's mobile home construction and placement standards.

Florida: installations follow FS 320 and Rule 15C-1/15C-2 (DHSMV) with licensed installers and installation decals; county building permits, tie-down and wind-zone compliance apply. Coastal counties may require Wind Zone II/III homes.
