Manufactured home requirements:

- Georgia rule: septic approval from county Environmental Health comes BEFORE the mobile home move-in permit (GA DPH rule 511-3-1) - call Environmental Health first, especially for a lot with an existing septic system
- Existing septic system evaluation required before relocating a mobile home onto a lot with an existing system (district form)

MANUFACTURED HOME NOTES

- Manufactured home placement requires building, electrical, and mechanical permits plus a purchase agreement/title/bill of sale with serial number and a current-year tax receipt (or shipping invoice if new).
- One joint Inspections Department serves unincorporated Lowndes County and the cities of Valdosta, Lake Park, Dasher, and Hahira; permits can be purchased online.
- Land use/zoning is governed by the Lowndes County Unified Land Development Code (ULDC): [lowndescounty.com/157/Unified-Land-Development-Code](https://www.lowndescounty.com/157/Unified-Land-Development-Code)

Georgia: installation must follow the state Rules for Manufactured Homes (O.C.G.A. Title 8-2, Art. 2) using state-licensed installers; an installation permit and insignia are required, and local permits/inspections apply.
