Manufactured home requirements:

- Florida septic permits are now a state DEP program, but this county's health department Environmental Health office still takes the applications and issues the permits locally
- Has its own repair permit application

MANUFACTURED HOME NOTES

- County maintains a dedicated mobile home permits page; applications are submitted online through the Volusia County Connect Live permitting portal
- All mobile home setups must be performed by an installer licensed per Rule 15C-2.0073(1), Florida Administrative Code
- Permit Center email PermitCtr@volusia.gov; main Growth and Resource Management line (386) 736-2700; county permits cover unincorporated areas only (cities have their own building departments)

Florida: installations follow FS 320 and Rule 15C-1/15C-2 (DHSMV) with licensed installers and installation decals; county building permits, tie-down and wind-zone compliance apply. Coastal counties may require Wind Zone II/III homes.
